is an example of a graphic using **Text Wrap - Square**. Notice that the text wraps squarely around graphic. When using square text wrap, make sure graphic is small enough and there is enough text. Other wise it will not look nice and will be better placed at the beginning of the text as in the example below.

This is an example of a graphic using text wrap - square. Notice that the text wraps around the graphic. When using square text wrap, make sure the graphic is small enough and there is enough text. Other wise it will not look nice and will be better placed at the beginning of the text.

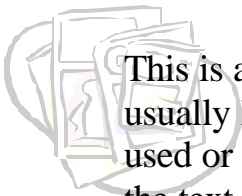
This is an example of a graphic using **Text Wrap - Edit Wrap Points**. Notice that the text wraps around the shape of the graphic. This is often a better choice because the text fits better and looks better when placed in this fashion.

is an example of a graphic using **Text Wrap – In Front of Text**. Notice that the graphic is on top of the text.

This is an example of a graphic using **Text Wrap – Behind Text**. This usually looks good if the graphic colors have been lightened or **washout** is used or if the text is large and bolded. Notice that the graphic is on behind the text.
