Local Scholarship Guide 2018-2019

Mifflin County High School offers seniors a variety of scholarship opportunities. Whether a student is attending a 4 year college or university, a 2 year college, a trade/technical school, or a certificate program, there are local scholarships available to help ease the cost of tuition. Each scholarship has its own set of eligibility and application requirements. Seniors are encouraged to check the scholarship wall frequently from January until May.

Alicia's Spirit Alive Scholarship: Alicia Bray was a talented athlete at Indian Valley High School and a dedicated physician's assistant after graduating from Penn State and Shenandoah. This award is given in her memory.

Eligibility Requirements:

- High school senior
- Attending 4 year college, 2 year college, or trade/technical school
- Career in medical field; minimum 3.0 GPA;
- Must have competed in a PIAA high school sport

AMCE Scholarships: AMCE is the local teacher union for teachers of Mifflin County School District. Money is raised through jeans days that are held throughout the school year.

Belleville Civic Club Scholarship: Belleville Civic Club is a community service organization dedicated to the betterment of Menno and Union Townships.

Burnham Lions Club Scholarship: The Burnham Lions Club is a service organization operating in Derry Township.

- Pursuing post-secondary education that is 2 years or longer

C. Ray Price Memorial Scholarship: The C. Ray Price Scholarship is given in memory of former MCSD Business Manager Mr. C. Ray Price.

- High school senior and resident of Mifflin County for at least 2 years
- Majoring in Business and have high academic achievement in high school

Central PA Chapter 791-Vietnam Veterans Scholarship: The Central PA Chapter 791 of Vietnam Veterans is a membership organization comprised of veterans of the Vietnam War.

Debra Tate-Anderson Scholarship I and II: Debra Tate-Anderson was a beloved Art teacher in the Mifflin County School District who lost her battle with cancer in 2016.

Eligibility Requirements:

- MCHS senior attending accredited college/university (full-time in face-to-face classes on campus) in the US in the fall of 2019. Recipient need not be a US citizen.
- "B" or higher average in previous two school years and majoring in science, engineering or math program (science includes biology, biochemistry, chemistry, computer science, environmental sciences, medical and health sciences, earth and atmospheric science, or physics. This does not include 2 year programs).

Delta Kappa Gamma Grant-in-Aid: Delta Kappa Gamma is an organization made up of past educators.

Eligibility Requirements:

- High school senior
- Planning a career in education
- Attending an accredited four year college
- Scholastic achievement, shows leadership ability, good moral values, active in school and community activities
- May be a boy or a girl

Excellence and Community Service Award: South Hills School of Business and Technology sponsors this award for high school seniors in local school districts. The award is intended to recognize students involved in community service.

Harry Price Scholarship: The Harry Price Scholarship was set up under the will of Mr. Price in March 1968. The scholarship is intended to help students in financial need to pursue a post-secondary education.

Helen S. Price Memorial Scholarship: The Helen S. Price Memorial Scholarship is given in memory of former MCS D teacher Mrs. Helen S. Price.

Number of Awards: 2 (\$1,100 each)

Eligibility Requirements:

- High school senior and resident of Mifflin County for at least 2 years
- Majoring in Education and have high academic achievement in high school

Husky Club Scholarship: The Husky Club Scholarship is funded through the Husky Club, which works in concession stands throughout the school year during sporting events.

John and Joann Kornmann Scholarship: John Kornmann was a respected dentist in Mifflin County. He and his wife valued education and were graduates of Penn State and Temple. This scholarship was set up as part of his estate.

- High school senior living in former Lewistown Area High School attendance area
- Attending Penn State or Temple in the fall of 2019
- Majoring in Agriculture, Medicine, Biology, or any other science

Kops 4 Kids Scholarship: Kops 4 Kids is sponsored by Mifflin County Kops 4 Kids organization and is intended to support students pursuing a career in criminal justice or emergency services.

Amount: \$1,000

Deadline: May 3

Eligibility Requirements:

- High school senior pursuing a career in criminal justice or emergency services
- Children of members of the Kops 4 Kids organization are not eligible to apply

Juniata Valley Striders Scholarship: The Juniata Valley Striders is a local organization formed in 1980 and committed to promoting running and fitness in Mifflin and Juniata Counties through various events.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Mifflin or Juniata County senior
- Participated in 2 seasons of cross country, 2 seasons of indoor track, or 2 seasons of spring track

Lewistown VFW Scholarship: The Lewistown VFW is a veterans service organization comprised of eligible veterans and military service members from the active, guard, and reserve forces.

Amount: \$1,000

Number of Awards: 4 (2 boys and 2 girls will receive \$1,000 each)

- High school senior planning to attend a four year college/university, two year college, or trade/technical school in the fall of 2019
- Demonstrate financial need

The Margaret "Peg" Carpenter Miller Scholarship: Ms. Margaret "Peg" Carpenter Miller grew up in Mifflin County and worked with PennDOT in Harrisburg. This scholarship is given from the funds of her estate that she left to seniors of MCSD. Ms. Miller always talked about her fond memories of growing up in Mifflin County.

Amount: Awards will total \$70,000

- High school senior attending an accredited 4 year college/university or 2 year college/trade/technical school upon graduating from high school
- Will pursue a bachelor's or associate degree in music, science, or medicine
- Full-time student during term of the award and enrolled in face-to-face classes
- Recipient need not be a US citizen

Meghan M. Johnson Memorial Scholarship: Meghan M. Johnson, a 2017 Lower Dauphin High School graduate, lost her battle with stage IV glioblastoma brain cancer 6 months after graduating from high school.
