



It is critical that all emergency contact information is up to date. Please contact the office if phone numbers change.

All visitors must sign-in at the Main Office.

Students are able to take up to 5 Educational Trip days per school year. Be sure to fill out the form and have it signed PRIOR to taking the educational trip. *A report is due to the office within 3 days of returning from the trip for it to be considered a lawful absence.*

If your child is absent from school, it is imperative that an excuse for that absence be sent to school within 3 days of the missed day.

School Bus Safety

October 19-23 is National School Bus Safety Week. Please remind your children to keep everything in his or her backpack, never walk on to the street until the bus has stopped, look both ways before crossing the street, never stop to pick up a dropped item, and always be alert while at the bus stop. Stay sitting safely in the seat and don't stand up on the bus until the bus stops completely. Following these tips can help to keep everyone safe on and off the bus.

Lock Down Drill

As a part of our safety practices, we will be conducting a Lock Down Drill on October 20th. During the Lock Down Drill, our staff will secure the students in a safe location. The local Emergency Management Agency, the local police, and the state police are invited to attend this drill. You can rest assured that Indian Valley Elementary Center is practicing safe procedures.

Remote Friday Attendance Reminders

We appreciate all families helping their children learn remotely on Fridays. Below you will find some tips so that your child is reported as present instead of absent on a Remote Friday:

- ❖ **By 9:30am**, please report through Class Dojo or Google Classroom that your child will be attending on Friday. If you are unable to report through Class Dojo or Google Classroom, please do one of the two following:
 - Call the school office between 5:30-9:30am; Leave a message with child's full name, grade, and date of birth
 - Email the attendance secretary (kjn28@mcsdk12.org) between 5:30-9:30am with the child's full name, grade, and date of birth.
- ❖ **Complete all work provided by the teacher.**

Reporting as present AND completion of work is required or a student will receive an unlawful absence.

If internet connectivity is an issue, families may request a computer lab time by calling the office in advance of each Friday. You may also contact your child's teacher if you are in need of paper copies of the assignments.
