

## Attendance and Truancy

Regular attendance in elementary school sets up a good pattern for your child's entire school career. Show your child that school comes first by trying to save days off for illness. Also, when possible, schedule routine doctor and dentist appointments for after school or during school breaks. Students must turn in a written excuse within three (3) days following an absence. Excuses must be written and signed by the student's parent or guardian. Please make sure you have your child's first and LAST name on the excuse. Failure to submit a written excuse within three (3) days will result in the absence(s) being recorded as an unlawful absence. Students will be considered tardy to school if they arrive after 8:20 AM, but before 9:30 AM.
