REMOTE LEARNING ATTENDANCE REMINDERS:

- ✓ Students should check in with their teacher by 9:30am each day. If a student cannot do so, a parent should call the office by 9:30.
- ✓ Assignments need to be completed each day to be considered present.
- ✓ If students do not check in and complete work daily, the days will be counted as unlawful absences.
 - After (4) unlawful absences, a School Attendance Improvement Conference will be required
 - After (6) unlawful absences, a truancy referral will be made to Children & Youth, and a Truancy Elimination Plan will be developed
 - If unlawful absences continue to accumulate, the school has the option of filing charges with the District Magistrate.
