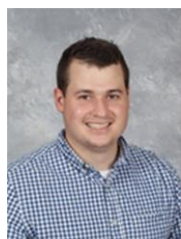
The celebration is a reward for those students who have displayed positive behavior throughout this quarter. Documented negative behavior throughout the month of May will impact a student's participation on field day.
