Attendance Reminders

Regular attendance in elementary school sets up a good pattern for your child's entire school career. Please remember:

- ❖ Students must submit a written excuse within three (3) school days following the absence. Excuses must include the child's full name, the date and reason for absence, and a parent/guardian signature. Failure to submit excuses can result in unlawful absences.
- ❖ Students arriving after 8:20am are tardy. Students arriving after 9:30am or leaving before 2:00pm will be marked absent for ½ a day.
- ❖ Students are able to take up to five (5) Educational Trip days per school year. Be sure to fill out the form and have it signed PRIOR to taking the trip. A report is due to the office within 3 days of returning from the trip to be considered lawful.

Homelessness Awareness Week – November 15-19

Schools and communities across the nation set aside the week before Thanksgiving to recognize the challenges faced by those experiencing homelessness. In honor of this week, MCSD staff will be raising money to help the local homeless shelter. In exchange for a \$5 donation, staff will have the opportunity to dress down on Friday, November 19th. If you or your child(ren) would like to join the district's effort in helping the local shelter, please call Jane Neff at 717-248-0102 for more information.

You can also help by wearing a **red shirt** on Friday, November 19th or by letting families in need know that help is available. A student is considered homeless if he/she is lacking a fixed, regular, or adequate nighttime residence. Mifflin County School District has a clothing, toiletry, and school supply pantry. Our school counselors can assist students in securing items they need from the pantry and can direct families to other resources throughout the community.



Flexible Instruction Days (FIDs): MCSD will use up to (3) FIDs if needed for snow days. In order to be counted as "present" on a FID, each child must check in for attendance between 5:30-9:30am AND complete the required work.
