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*Dear Strodes Mills Families,*

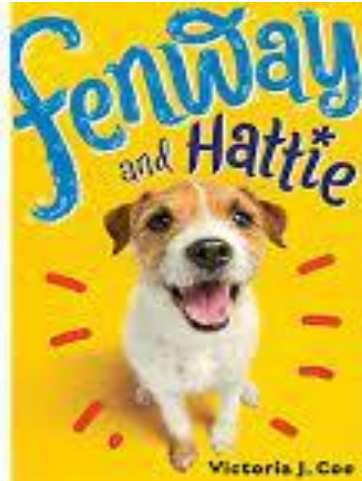

### ATTENDANCE
