MCS D Summer School Information

WHO: Students in grades 6-12 who failed a course(s) during the 2021-2022 school year.

APPLICATIONS: The application process begins at the MCMS guidance office. The student's school counselor, Mrs. Foor (6th Grade) jaf28@mcsdk12.org and Mr. McCardell (7th grade) alm21@mcsdk12.org will help with determining eligibility for summer school. The counselor will also need to complete part of the registration form. Applications will be accepted through June 16th; however, students may begin prior to the 16th, once an application is received. Please call or email your counselor with questions.

DATES: In-person session days will be from Tuesday, June 14th - Thursday, July 7th. Facility hours will be on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm. Attendance at the facility is not required to complete the coursework with the exception of the completion of exams. Exams must be completed in Room C207 under the supervision of Summer School staff. Daily attendance is recommended, though, as staff members will be available during these hours to assist students.

COST: There is no cost to students or families of the Mifflin County School District.

CURRICULUM: Most curricula will be self-paced online courses. Some courses may also be offered as an independent study with a curriculum developed by the MCS D Summer School staff.

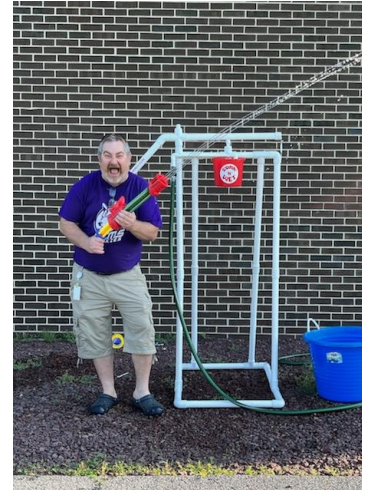
LOCATION: The Alpha classroom, Room C207, 2nd floor, "C" wing of the Mifflin County High School will be the Summer School facility for students in grades 6-12.

COMMITMENT: Students must be aware of and adhere to all rules and regulations contained in the 2021-2022 MCS D Secondary Student Handbook and the 2022 Summer School Handbook.

TRANSPORTATION: All students must provide their own transportation.

From the Nurse



As your child prepares for their middle school years, please note the following PA Department of Health school health requirements:

6th Grade Vaccinations and Physical Examination: The school nurse will accept a completed physical examination with the student's healthcare provider from up to one year prior to the first day of school this year or at any time during the sixth-grade year. A copy of the child's immunization record must be completed and turned in with the physical. Prior to the 2022-2023 school year, every student entering seventh grade must have a TDAP and an MCV (meningococcal) vaccination. These vaccines are a state requirement and failure to either turn in proof of vaccination or an exemption due to moral or religious belief can result in the student being excluded from school until proof of the vaccine or appointment to get one is turned in. Students may request physical examination forms in the school nurse's office or they can be downloaded and printed from the district's webpage.

7th Grade Dental: The school nurse will accept a dental form dated from up to one year prior to the school start date or anytime during their seventh-grade year. It is a state requirement that every student in 7th grade must have a dental exam. Dental forms can be picked up in the nurse's office or downloaded from the district's webpage.



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
