Practice How to Open a Locker

From the Nurse

As your child prepares for his or her middle school years, please note the following PA Department of Health school health requirements:

6th Grade Vaccinations and Physical Examination: The school nurse will accept a completed physical examination with the student's healthcare provider from up to one year prior to the first day of school this year or at any time during the sixthgrade year. A copy of the child's immunization record must be completed and turned in with the physical. Prior to the 2023-2024 school year, every student entering seventh grade must have a TDAP and an MCV (meningococcal) vaccination. These vaccines are a state requirement, and failure to either turn in proof of vaccination or an exemption due to moral or religious belief can result in the student being excluded from school until proof of the vaccine or appointment to get one is turned in. Students may request physical examination forms in the school nurse's office, or they can be downloaded and printed from the district's webpage.

** The exclusion date for 7th grade students not compliant with immunizations is September 7th.

7th **Grade Dental:** The school nurse will accept a dental form dated from up to one year prior to the school start date or anytime during their seventh-grade year. It is a state requirement that every student in **7**th grade must have a dental exam. Dental forms can be picked up in the nurse's office or downloaded from the district's webpage.

<u>As a friendly reminder</u>, students are NOT permitted to carry any prescriptions or over the counter medications on their persons during school hours. The only medications students may carry with a physicians order are epi-pens, diabetic supplies, inhalers. Parents and guardians must deliver medications to the school nurse in the original prescription bottles or packaging along with the MCSD prescription medication form completed by the prescribing physician.

Please call Mrs. Sheetz if your child needs to take any medication at school. Finally, please call or email the MCMS school nurse throughout the school year if your student has a change in his or her health status and needs any additional support or assistance during school hours. Please also keep in mind, morning meds should be given at home.

Preparing for a New School Year

It's important to establish routines in the weeks before school resumes. Consider the following tips as you start preparing for our opening day on August 30.

1. **Implement a Bedtime -** The first thing you'll need to get your child used to is a new bedtime. To determine the best bedtime, determine what wake-up time will be first as in how much time does your child

need in the morning before leaving for school? Then, work backward. Your child should get 9-10 hours of sleep each night. So, depending on their age and sleep needs, you'll come with an appropriate bedtime.

- 2. **Implement a Wake-up Time** The obvious counterpart to a set bedtime is a wake-up time! Using a similar process, start implementing a wake-up time corresponding to the bedtimes already set up. For older children, you can encourage responsibility by asking them to set an alarm clock.
- 3. Try Out a Practice Run on Routines Plan your routines ahead of time. Some may include these tasks:
- Pick out your clothes the night before
- Pack a lunch and water bottle in the morning
- Make sure your backpack is ready
- Eat breakfast
- 4. **Emphasize the Positive -** A new school year brings new clothes and school supplies, but it also gives your child a fresh opportunity to make friends and find new interests.

- Please note the following Mitchell Field Student/Guardian Guidelines for Varsity Football games. There were some changes to the guidelines for this year:
 - All students in grades 6 through 12 MUST show a current MCSD school ID to be granted admission into the game.
 - Students in grades K through 7th MUST be accompanied by a supervising adult or they will not be permitted into the game.
 - No backpacks are permitted.
 - Parents/Guardians are responsible for student (K 7th) behavior and supervision inside the gates of Mitchell Field.
 - MCSD students (8th 12th) will sit in the designated DAWG Pound Student Section.
 - o MCSD students (K 7th) will sit in the stands with parents/guardians.
 - No walking/running around the outside of the field during the event.
 - o No balls, bicycles, scooters or skateboards are permitted.
- August 8 Deadline for 7th grade students to register for junior high fall sports.
