Early Bird Study Program

Mifflin County Middle School offers an early morning study program called Early Bird. At Early Bird, students can receive help with homework, study for tests, work on class projects, and generally receive extra support with their studies.

This program is offered in the library every morning from 7:30 - 8:00 a.m. **Students should come directly to the library to sign in the logbook.** If a student needs to go to his or her locker to get materials, an Early Bird facilitator will sign a pass.

Entering Absence Excuses Online

When students are absent from school, parents have the option of submitting written excuses to the office or entering excuses online via Skyward Family Access. 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School Bus Expectations

We've been receiving a number of referrals from drivers of our students not acting safely on the bus. Please communicate with your student expectations for the bus.

Bus riding is a privilege, not a right. Cooperation with the bus driver and fellow students will result in a safe journey for all passengers. Failure to comply with rules may result in losing the privilege of riding school buses.



On The Bus:

- 1. Keep hands and feet inside the bus and out of the aisle at all times.
- 2. Assist in keeping the bus safe and sanitary at all times.
- 3. Do not shout or talk in an excessively loud manner.
- 4. Treat bus equipment with respect never tamper with the bus or equipment.
- 5. Do not leave books, lunches, or other articles on the bus.
- 6. Do not throw anything out of the bus windows.
- 7. Do not throw anything inside of the bus.
- 8. Do not engage in horseplay, fighting, or any other behavior that may distract the driver.
- 9. Be courteous to fellow students and the bus driver.
- 10. Do not put anything in the aisle at any time.
- 11. Follow the bus driver's rules regarding cell phones and electronic devices. Whether or not these devices are permitted on the bus is at the discretion of the driver.

Safety Drill

On Tuesday, October 10 at 8:30 a.m., MCMS will be conducting a lockdown drill. The purpose of a school lockdown drill is to protect the children and adults in the building from a potential emergency such as the presence of a school shooter. As with fire drills and other safety programs, the hope is to acclimate students and teachers to a procedure that they will be able to follow quickly, effectively and safely.



Morning Meetings & Status Checks

What are Morning Meetings?

Every morning, during first period, teachers facilitate Morning Meetings with their classes. The topics discussed range from light-hearted preferences like favorite candy bars to more substantial subjects such as coping skills. Students have the option to actively participate or choose to observe.

Why do we do Morning Meetings?

The overarching goal of these meetings is to foster stronger bonds between the staff and students, ultimately cultivating a greater sense of community within the school environment.

What is a Status Check?

In addition to Morning Meetings, students will be utilizing the PBIS app to complete a "Status Check." This tool serves as a means for students to monitor their own mental well-being and assess their readiness to engage in learning. If a student consistently indicates feelings of anger, sadness, or stress, the School Counselor will arrange a meeting with him or her and, if necessary, reach out to a parent or guardian.

The staff at MCMS encourages all students to embrace this opportunity.




MCMS will observe Red Ribbon Week during the week of October 30 -November 3.

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


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
