

Homeless Awareness Week

Funds are used to purchase clothing, toiletries, and school supplies for displaced students. **Students can also show your support by wearing a red shirt on Friday, November 17th.**

If you are experiencing homelessness, please know that help is available. Please reach out to your child's teacher, principal, nurse, or counselor. They will connect you with one of the district's social workers, who can assist you with securing necessary resources.
