Attendance: Students arriving after 8:20am will be marked Tardy.

Students arriving after 9:30am or leaving before 2:00pm will be marked absent for a ½ day.

Excuses must be returned within 3 days of an absence to avoid absence being marked unexcused.

Be sure to submit a "Permission to Give Medication" form for students who need to take meds/inhalers at school.

Students are able to take up to 5 Educational Trip days per school year. Be sure to fill out the form and have it signed PRIOR to taking the educational trip. A report is due to the office within 3 days of returning from the trip for it to be considered a lawful absence

Attendance Reminders

Regular attendance in elementary school sets up a good pattern for your child's entire school career. Please remember:

- Students must submit a written excuse within three (3) school days following the absence. Excuses must include the child's full name, the date and reason for absence, and a parent/guardian signature. Failure to submit excuses can result in unlawful absences.
- Students arriving after 8:20 am are tardy. Students arriving after 9:30am or leaving before 2:00pm will be marked absent for ½ a day.
- Students are able to take up to five (5) educational trip days per school year. Be sure to fill out an educational trip form **PRIOR** to your trip and approval. A one page report is due to the office within three (3) days of return from the trip for absences to be considered lawful.

Dress for the Weather

This time of the year brings many changes in weather. Please be sure your child has the appropriate layers for cold weather. Students are going outside for recess if the real-feel temperature is 32 degrees or higher. Please be sure they have coats, hats, and gloves to keep warm while playing outside.



Respectful, Responsible, Ready, & Safe

For December, we will focus on taking Initiative. Encouraging our students to take responsible actions on their own without prompting from others. Taking initiative with their own learning.
