According to the Pennsylvania Department of Education, the annual Pennsylvania System School Assessment provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards.

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Individual student scores, provided only to their respective schools, can be used to assist teachers in identifying students who may be in need of additional educational opportunities, and school scores provide information to schools and districts for curriculum and instruction improvement discussions and planning.

### ATTENTION PARENTS IN THE MORNING DROP-OFF LINE

Due to the high level of congestion in the parking lot and across Green Avenue in the morning drop off line, we are asking that all families pull forward to the first cross walk. The staff on duty will be located at the first crosswalk to ensure students can cross the bus lane safely. The buses will also be moving forward blocking the middle crosswalk. If you let your students out at the middle crosswalk we have been using, have them walk down to the first crosswalk to the staff on duty to cross.

Please instruct your student not cross at a crosswalk without a staff person.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Students arriving after 8:20 AM are tardy.

Students arriving after 9:30 AM or leaving before 2:00 PM will be marked absent for  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a day.

Excuses must be returned within three (3) days of an absence.

Excuses should include the student's full name, the date of and reason for absence, and a parent/quardian signature.

See your child's First Day Packet for information on submitting excuses via Family Access.

#### TRANSPORTATION

If a student will not be riding the bus, submit a written note with the student's full name, the time of pick-up, and who will be picking up the student.

Please park in the parking lot or along Green Avenue during dropoff/dismissal.

Please DO NOT park or drop-off/pick-up students along Kish Street or in the Bus Lane.

Remain in your vehicle during dismissal.

Afternoon dismissal begins at 2:45 PM. Pick-ups/walkers will be dismissed at 2:50 PM.
