- Call to Order / Introduction

- Principal/Building Leader Report provided by Travis Zook
  - Grandparents Day and STEAM Fair are scheduled for May.
  - Principals are planning a spelling bee for grades 3-5. It will start as an in-class competition, and the top five from each class/grade will move on to the next round on the stage. It is not associated with a spelling bee competition this year, but we may consider doing that in the future so students can advance to state competitions.

- Treasurer's Report
  - Account balance: \$54,150.86
  - We do not make any money from the Book Fair. \$11,000 will be written out to cover costs.
  - Reimbursements will be coming out of the account over the next few weeks
  - Beach Day – We will need to figure out if we are buying popsicles or help pay for Rita's.
  - Field Day – May need to rent a golf cart if we do not have enough donated to use that day. We will also need to buy supplies for snow cones.
- Feedback on Ag Lab and Book Fair

- Ag Lab – The kids seemed to stay engaged and have fun. We need to schedule early for next year. Ang Breon is the new contact person to work with the Ag Lab.
- Book Fair went well. Sold between \$18,000-19,000. We sold about \$3,000 more than last year. Scholastic is pushing to set up a Fall Book Fair next year. It would only be books. If we do the fall fair, we would get an extra 10% added to the spring book fair for teachers. Megan suggested adding the Fall Book Fair to the Open House in the fall since families are already in the building. It would only be a few carts of books. Megan will check if we still get 10% even if we do not sell many books at the Fall fair. Travis suggested a donation for used books or a book drive to set.
  - All in favor of trying Fall Book Fair next year.
- Grandparents Day – May 5-8<sup>th</sup>. Coffee shop theme. Teachers will be signing up for a day/time soon. H&S will do a bingo and interview activity paper. H&S is providing coffee and donuts.
- Committee Updates
  - Field Day: May 21, rain date is May 22
    - Volunteer sign-ups are starting tonight. Emails will also be sent out soon. We will also need help with snow cones.
    - The setup will be the day before. We usually rent a large Bluetooth speaker. We rented it for Field Day, Movie Night, and Limo Ride. All in favor to buy a Bluetooth speaker instead of renting one multiple times during the year.
  - Yearbook
    - This did not work well this year. There are no ads for this year, but we will be able to cover the cost of the yearbook. This should be delegated to 1-2 people early next year.
  - Fundraisers
    - Meat Raffle in April – Keyona will help set it up. Half of the funds may be directed to playground upgrades.
      - Tickets are ready to go home. It will start on March 31<sup>st</sup> and will be due on May 14<sup>th</sup>. The drawing will be on May 17<sup>th</sup>. Each kid will get 10 tickets.
      - We need to decide on next year's fundraisers at the next meeting.
  - Spring Family Outdoor Movie: May 9
    - Movie Suggestions: Despicable Me 4, Little Rascals, Angels in the Outfield, The Lorax
    - We can pick four movies and have the 5<sup>th</sup> graders vote.
