Mifflin County High School Parking Permit Rules/Regulations

Parking Permit Rules/Regulations:

***All paper work must be completed fully prior to receiving a MCHS parking permit. VALID PA DRIVER'S LICENSE OR THE EQUIVALENT MUST BE SUBMITTED UPON COMPLETION OF THE APPLICATION. PARKING PERMITS WILL NOT BE ISSUED/RESERVED FOR STUDENTS WHO POSSESS A DRIVER'S PERMIT.**

*Parking permits must be paid in full (cash or check for \$50.00 through March 1, 2026 or \$30 March 1, 2026 through the end of the 2025-2026 school year) to be picked up. Passes will be issued beginning Monday, August 4, 2025.

*Any vehicle parked on school district property may be searched by school officials at any time for just cause and without a search warrant.

*Parking passes must be displayed at all times to park in the student lot. Failure to display a parking pass may result in a parking ticket from \$5 to \$25.

*All vehicles are required to have rear view mirrors PAVC Title 75. All passes must be displayed on the rear view mirror to be valid.

**Students are NOT permitted to leave Mifflin County High School and go to their car at any time during the school day.*

*Passes will be sold on a first come/first serve basis. Students may choose to purchase a pass for the Student Lot or the Marcal Paper/First Quality Field lot, but must have the proper pass displayed. Once the passes available for the student lot have been sold out, all others must purchase a pass for the Marcal Paper/First Quality Field lot

*Students who leave school grounds without permission will have their privileges suspended or revoked.

*Students must obey all traffic rules and regulations to and from school and while on school district property. Students that violate these rules and regulations may be subject to forfeiture of their parking passes.

*Students are requested to lock their vehicles. Mifflin County High School/Mifflin County School District will not be responsible for losses incurred due to vandalism, accidents, theft. STUDENTS WHO PARK ON SCHOOL PROPERTY DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.

*Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked at any time due to violations of this application or student driving rules as stated in the MCSD student handbook or any other violation of school or district policies/procedures.

*By checking the box below and upon being granted a Mifflin County High School parking permit, parents and students agree to NOT utilize transportation provided by the Mifflin County School District for the purpose of daily transportation to and from school. Student's names will be removed from the official bus roster. Parents must contact the transportation office should the student require the need to reestablish district transportation to and from school.
