 - Fall Fundraiser Update: \$26,051 was raised. Prizes, limo, and pizza costs: \$3,683. Total profit of \$22,367.75.
 - Account Balance: \$56,804.91
 - We can no longer reimburse taxes when paying for reimbursements since we are tax exempt. We have talked with the bank and can get a debit card that will be locked in the school with the checkbook to use for expenses. We will also set up our own Amazon account to limit reimbursements while using our tax exempt status.
