Even though the days are shorter and the weather colder, every school day matters! Please help your child arrive on time, ready to learn each morning. Maintaining strong attendance in December helps students stay on track academically and reduces stress when they return from break. Thank you for your continued

commitment to regular attendance.

When your child is absent:

- -Notes must be turned in within three school days of the student being absent.
- -If no note is received, the day becomes an unlawful absence.

How to turn in excuses:

- -Send a note with your child to school.
- -Drop it off at the school.
- -Submit a note on Skyward. Click here for directions.
- -Calling the o ce does NOT count as the excuse. We must have written documentation.

Unlawful absences

- -After a students 4th unlawful absence School Attendance Improvement Conference must be held with parent/guardian and administration
- -After a students 6th unlawful absence a truancy referral is made to Children and Youth Services and Clarvida (formerly Raystown Developmental Service) and a Truancy Elimination Plan is created.
- -On the 7th unlawful absence A citation is sent to our District Magistrate and a court date is set up by the Magistrate.
















Winter Health Reminders from the Nurse's O ce

A healthy school environment requires the cooperation and effort of us all working together. During this time of year we tend to see a higher incidence of strep throat, respiratory and gastrointestinal illnesses. Mrs. Eagle and Mrs. Eckley, our School Nurses, would like to remind everyone that they can help to protect themselves and their families from many of these airborne illnesses by following the Habits for Good Health recommended by the Center for Disease Control.



<u>Please note</u> that children who have a fever or who need to take antibiotics for infections such as strep throat, conjunctivitis, ear infections, etc., should stay home until they have taken the medicine for at least 24 hours, their temperature is less than 100.0 F (without fever reducing medicine), and they feel better.

Medication Policy

If your child has not submited the Over-the Counter Medication form to the Nurse's O ce, your child will not receive medication at school. Forms are available in the nurse's o ce. As a reminder, students are NOT permitted to carry any medications on their person during school hours. This includes cough drops, medicated creams, eye drops, or anything else that is used for medicinal purposes. Any medication required to be taken at school MUST be transported to school by a parent/guardian or designated adult and accompanied by a physician's order. Parents and guardians are required to sign medications into the nurse's o ce at drop-off. If your child requires an inhaler, a new physician order must be submitted to the school nurse EACH school year before your child can carry an inhaler on their person. Failure to do so is a violation of the MCSD Medication Policy.

Parent Handbook for Elementary Schools

At Indian Valley Elementary Center, we strive to create a safe, respectful, and engaging learning environment for all students. To support this goal, we ask that families review the Parent Handbook for Elementary Schools, which outlines important policies, expectations, and guidelines. The handbook can be found at this Link. Board Policy 105.1 Noti cation - Review of Instructional Materials

Mi in County School District School Board Policy 105.1 requires annual notication to parents/guardians and students that parents/guardians and students have an opportunity to review

instructional materials and have access to information about the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques. Requests to review instructional materials and access information about the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques should be made by submitting a written request to the building principal.

Board Policy 906 - Complaint Procedures

Indian Valley Elementary Center is committed to maintaining a positive and responsive school environment. If you have a concern or complaint about Board policy and procedures, programs, personnel, operations or facilities, concerns should be addressed directly with the teacher, staff member or administrator involved. Many issues can be resolved through open and respectful communication. More information on complaint procedures is provided in Policy 906 of the MCSD Policy Manual.

2026-2027 Kindergarten Registration

The Mi in County School District is conducting registration for children who will be eligible for enrollment in a kindergarten class for the 2026-2027 school year. A child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2026. There are no exceptions or provisions made for early entrance to kindergarten.

Information gathered from this form will enable the district to properly plan for its new enrollees and will provide an opportunity for school o cials to communicate directly with parents and guardians concerning enrollment requirements.
